

Guidelines for the JRUUC Share-the-Plate Program

- Any member or friend of JRUUC (Reeber) may nominate an organization or project for the Share-the-Plate program.
- We invite nominations from Reebers of all ages, including individuals, committees, and groups.
- Each nomination must include all of the information requested on the Share-the-Plate Nomination Form, including the nominee's contact person and address. The requested information may be on the nomination form or on a document that is attached to the nomination form. A separate form is required for each nomination.
- The Social Justice Council is responsible for organization, selection, and management of the "Share-the-Plate" program and for proposing changes to these guidelines to be approved by the Board.

Priority will be given to organizations or projects that:

- Honor the JRUUC mission and support UU principles and purposes.
- Support our current focus or theme at JRUUC and, where appropriate, can supply speakers or present programs during a service or at other times.
- Are local, sustainable, and have participation on some level by one or more Reebers, but national or global organizations are not excluded.
- Are 501(c)3 non-profit organizations, but other not-for-profit organizations or projects will be considered.
- Represent a diversity of issues, interests, and community needs.
